

PENTAIR POLE POSITION - TERMS & CONDITIONS

**This competition is void where prohibited, taxed
or restricted by law.**

1. These terms and conditions (hereinafter: "Terms") describe the official rules related to the "Pentair Pole Position" contest, (hereinafter referred to as "Contest"). The participation to the Contest is free and does not include any obligation to buy any goods or services.
2. The Contest is organized by Pentair Thermal Management with registered offices at Romeinse straat 14, 3001 Leuven, Belgium (hereinafter: "Organizer"). For any questions related to this Contest, please contact us at koen.borremans@pentair.com
3. **This Contest is void where prohibited, taxed, or restricted by law. The Organizer has taken great care in drafting these Terms in accordance with applicable laws. If during the Contest however, these Terms show to be prohibited, taxed or limited by law in any of the countries where it is operated, the Organizer reserves the right to immediately suspend or terminate the Contest in that country and to exclude all citizens of that country from further participation. Such suspension, termination and/or exclusion shall under no circumstances entitle participants or potential participants to any form of damage compensation.**
4. You must fill out the registration form completely. You as Participant are exclusively responsible for providing accurate information in a timely manner.
5. Only one registration per e-mail address is allowed. Only one account per participant is allowed.
6. Participants must be of legal age in order to participate. Participants younger than 18 years must have permission from their parent or guardian to participate in Pentair Pole Position. They must be able to submit this permission in writing before receiving any prizes they may win.
7. By participating in Pentair Pole Position you automatically accept all terms and conditions.
8. Pentair employees are also welcome to participate in Pentair Pole Position. They are not eligible to win Pentair Pole Position prizes, but they may receive Pentair in-house rewards.
9. This Contest runs from 13 September 2014 until 30 May 2015, for the whole duration of the Formula E championship. The Contest is set up in nine (9) rounds, one round for each of the following Formula E races: Beijing (China), Putrajaya (Malaysia), Punta del Este (Uruguay), Buenos Aires (Argentina), [Round 5 – to be announced], Miami (USA), Long Beach (USA), Monte Carlo (Monaco) and Berlin (Germany).
10. Participants must submit their prognosis for each round on the website at the very latest on the day before the relevant race at 23h59 according to the time of the country where the relevant race takes place. A prognosis comprises the winning pilot and the fastest lap time for the relevant race.
11. The winner for each race is determined by the following procedure:
 1. Pentair checks who has guessed the winning pilot right.
 2. From those participants the 3 entrees closest to the fastest lap time – driven by classified drivers - from that race win.

12. With every race, 1 participant can win 1 iPod Nano (3rd best time + correct winning race pilot), Shuffle (2nd best time + correct winning race pilot) or Touch (1st best time + correct winning race pilot) each.
13. Prizes won cannot be exchanged for other prizes or for their value in money.
14. Pentair will contact the prize winners by e-mail. If a winner does not claim his or her prize within 1 week from the confirmation email, he or she forfeits the right to that prize.
15. Prizes are sent to the address the participant has entered upon registration.

After the 9th race (Berlin, Germany), from all the predictions made by participants, the person with the five best lap times predictions raced by a FE pilot during the Pole Position competition, wins the final prize: a trip to London for 2, including a travel arrangement and tickets to the FE race in London for a maximum total value of € 3,500. Pentair will communicate the exact terms & conditions at the appropriate time.

19. Pentair has the right to change the rules of play at any time.
